

## Ponderings of Patience

*Preparations for our Annual Turkey Dinner are Approaching!*

We are genuinely grateful for the significant number of people in our fellowship who help make the outreach of the Annual Turkey Dinner a reality. This year, the twelve hundred or so dinners, will be served on **Thursday and Friday, the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> of November from 4:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m.**

Our Annual Turkey Dinner is a wonderful way to extend our welcoming hospitality throughout the Northland. It is also a major fundraiser that has benefited our congregation through several major projects such as the remodeling of our kitchen as well as concrete work and the repair and resurfacing of the parking lot.

We are mindful that ten percent of our congregation's contributions immediately goes to a number of outreach causes every year, so the Turkey Dinner proceeds are a significant way to help us maintain our facilities and ministries.

Many of us also enjoy the great fellowship we experience through the various tasks achieved in preparing each Turkey Dinner and we welcome you to join us! Listed below are the preparation days and times, and the tasks to be accomplished on those particular days. We hope this listing helps you mark your calendar with the days and tasks where you would like to assist.

**Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, October 21, 22 and 23 and also October 28, 29 and 30** from 8:30 a.m. to approximately 2:30 p.m. each day, we cook and debone 80 turkeys.

**Monday, November 4<sup>th</sup>** from 8:30 a.m. until completion in early the afternoon, we will pull and clean up turnips.

**Tuesday, November 5<sup>th</sup>** from 8:00 a.m. until about 2:00 p.m., we cook bacon and cut onions

**Wednesday, November 6<sup>th</sup>** from 8:00 a.m. until about 2:00 p.m., we peel and slice turnips. At 2:00 p.m., we then set up tables and the Bazaar, and six people are needed to unload a truck. Then at 6:00 p.m., men of the church make one batch of rolls.

**Thursday and Friday November 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>, the Turkey Dinners are Served.** From 6:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m., men prepare rolls. From 8:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., turkey meat is placed in roasters, while dressing, green beans, potatoes and gravy, turnips and coleslaw are prepared. At 11:30 a.m., lunch is served for the workers. At 12:00 noon, we pinch rolls. At about 3:00 p.m. the Health Inspector arrives (on Thursday only). A few minutes before 4:00 p.m., the drive-through meals begin, and then from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., the community is served Turkey Dinners inside the fellowship hall. From 8:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. we clean up both days.

**Job 1:** Driver needed. Duties include driving the BCC Church van Sunday mornings. Prerequisites include mostly clean driving record (nothing more than a few speeding or parking tickets), and availability between 9 and 9:30am Sunday mornings, and again for a return trip, from noon to 12:30pm. This can be split between more than one person. Benefits include the joy of seeing approximately 9 happy and smiling children running from their front door to the van, then talking your ear off as they tell you every exciting thing that happened to them the past week (and some not-so-exciting things as well), while you're driving them to Sunday School. Van and gas are provided. You'll also have your very own garage door opener, van key, and reserved parking space in front of the garage.



**Job 2:** Sunday School teacher, for a small group of smart, fun, and funny middle schoolers, who are the most welcoming and accepting children to walk this earth. Benefits include as much laughter as you can handle; learning more about the Bible than you thought possible; and rewarding conversations with some pre-teen and early-teen children who are eager to learn and grow right along with you. We provide curriculum, as well as various alternative ideas for discussion topics. Preparation is helpful, but does not have to be intense--just toss them a discussion topic, or an idea for an art or craft project, and watch what these insightful kiddos can do! Prerequisites include a love for God, Jesus, the Bible, and children; a sense of humor is helpful (these kids love to smile and laugh); and availability between the hours of 9:45 and 10:45am on Sunday mornings. Teaching experience not required...if you can have a conversation with a small group of intelligent and eager pre-teens or young-teens, you can do this job! Candidates for this position may include individuals, couples, or teams that may fulfill this role on a rotating basis. (Benefits also include donuts and coffee, tea and water; sugar and creamer also included.)

To apply for either job, contact Jim--he's usually easy to find, he'll be at the pulpit making announcements at the beginning of both services; at other times he may be found running around the building and looking confused. To get his attention, you may trip him as you pass him in the halls, or wave something in front of his face--donuts and coffee usually get his attention. (He takes his coffee without creamer or sugar.)
